Inspection Procedure

If you have a 1996 or newer model year equipped with an OBD system, your vehicle will receive an on-board diagnostic (OBD) inspection.

- OBD systems are designed to alert drivers, with the check engine light, when something in the emission control system begins to deteriorate or fails.
- This system is designed to catch emission problems before they become a major concern.

Please Note:

- Vehicles presented for testing must be able to operate safely during the emission inspection.
- Vehicles are eligible to take a maximum of three free tests. A fee applies for subsequent tests (payment by cash or check only). Please see the station manager before proceeding to the testing area.

License Plate Renewal and Vehicle Titling Services Are Available At All Emission Test Stations.

- You can purchase a vehicle license plate sticker at all emission-testing locations.
- Vehicle titling is also available at all emission-testing locations in the office area. Please see clerk for details.

The private testing company offering License Plate Renewal and Titling Services charges a fee to process these transactions. Only cash or checks, payable to Envirotest Wisconsin LLC, are accepted.

Program Changes for 2010

Beginning with model year 2007, two new categories of vehicles will require testing:

- OBDII-compliant diesel fueled vehicles
- OBDII-compliant vehicles up to 14,000 pounds gvwr

The first test cycle for these vehicle will occur for vehicle registrations expiring in calendar year 2010. Vehicle owners will be notified of the testing requirement with their registration renewal notices or at the time they change ownership.

Testing Frequency

In 2009, newer vehicles with gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) under 8,501 pounds will require testing. The following model years require testing in 2009:

Registration Renewal Requirements

For vehicles with license plates expiring in 2009 the following model year vehicles must be tested:

1996, 1998, 2000, 2002, 2004, 2006

Change of Ownership Requirements

Vehicles that are more than five model years old will continue to need testing at the time of change of ownership. In 2009, the following model years will be tested at the time of change of ownership.

1996 - 2004

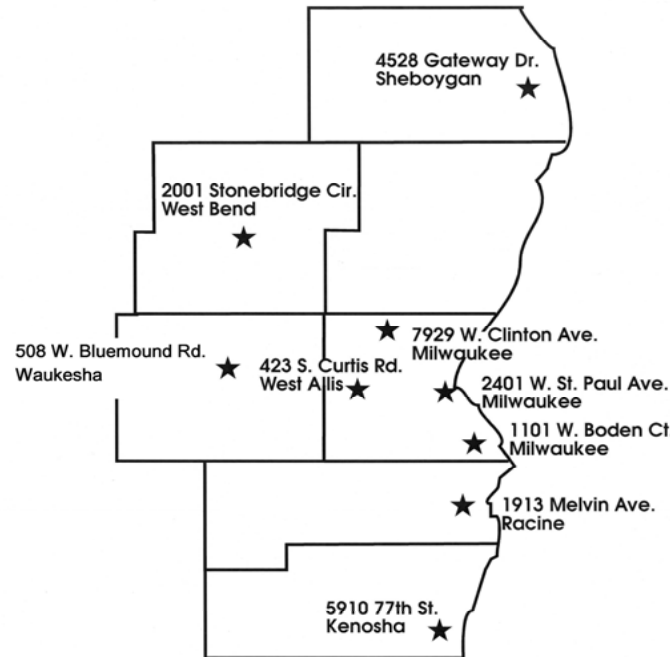
